

Training – Routes to the GMC Specialty Registrar

Certificate of Completion of Training (CCT)

- Successful completion of a full UK paediatric training programme is marked by the issue of a RITA G by the Postgraduate Deanery. For entry to the specialist register at the GMC, the trainee must apply to the RCPCH for confirmation of completion of training (CCT) at CCT@rcpch.ac.uk.
- Trainees are strongly advised to begin the application process as soon as possible (up to 6 months before CCT date). The RCPCH will assess your application and make a recommendation to the PMETB.

Certificate of Eligibility to the Specialist Register (CESR)

- If you are not in a UK CCT specialist training programme, or have entered a UK paediatric training programme at ST3 or above so will not complete a full UK specialist training programme, you may nevertheless have the knowledge, skills and experience required for entry to the Specialist Register.
- To be considered for entry to the Specialist Register, your knowledge skills and experience will have to be evaluated and this starts with an application to PMETB.
